Applications are now open for the 2018 Surf Life Saving Sunshine Coast 18+ Advanced Lifesaving Program, PULSE. The live-in development program will be held **Friday 19th – Sunday 21st October, 2018** at Sunshine Coast Recreation Centre - Currimundi.

This program will extend the participants' lifesaving knowledge and skills in a hands on, scenario-based learning environment. PULSE is open to **any** patrolling member over the age of 18! Ideally, we encourage all clubs to identify 1-2 participants to apply for the program.

Who: The program is open to all active Surf Life Saving Sunshine Coast members over the age of 18 (any patrolling member) who hold a proficient Bronze Medallion.

Registration: Applications **must** be completed online at <https://goo.gl/forms/IMkML2JXnn2a3sRs1>
Applications will close **9am Monday 10th September 2018**.

Cost: \$165 + GST per participant. This registration fee includes all meals, accommodation, program activities, program resources and PULSE memorabilia. The Sunshine Coast Branch will invoice Clubs for the total cost of all participants who are accepted to attend.

PLEASE NOTE: Completing the application does not confirm acceptance to the development program. Members are encouraged to discuss attendance at the program with their club as all nominations will be sent to clubs for endorsement. In addition, payment for attendance will be the responsibility of the participant via the club unless other arrangements are in place within your club to fund member attendance.

Any applicant that withdraws from the camp after being selected will not receive a refund; however the Club may be able to nominate an alternative participant.

Transport: All participants will be responsible for their own transport to and from the PULSE program.

Blue Card: All participants will require a current working/volunteering with children blue card.

Program: The program starts at 3pm on the Friday and runs to approximately 2pm on the Sunday. The program covers topics such as decision-making under pressure, situational awareness, major incident response processes, and practical sessions on search and rescue techniques.
