

This is required for EVERY person joining

ie 1x Parent + 1x Nipper = 2x following these steps

Step 1 ... creates your membership with the club

Step 2 ... creates your login details to your membership portal

to update details, renew membership, complete training, and many other things

Step 3 ... enables renewing & updating to become one transaction rather than several individual

If you have ever been a member of any club in your lifetime, you will need to initiate a club transfer – the system will automatically pickup on this through your name and date of birth and prompt you to transfer.

Step 1 – Joining the Club

1. Visit <https://sls.com.au/join/>

a) Under NO ... click on Join and follow the questions

- Surf Life Saving Club
- State = Qld
- Club = Redcliffe Peninsula

b) Enter personal details & the captcha code ... and continue

c) Repeat above steps for every person

Step 2 – Membership Portal

2. Visit <https://members.sls.com.au>

if you enter the nipper/s first you can then create a family group from the adult member

a) Click on “click here” in the yellow box under the Login red button

b) Follow the ‘prompts’

c) Repeat the above steps for every person

Step 3 – Family Group

3. To create Family Group

a) Login to your member portal <https://members.sls.com.au>

b) Click on “Memberships”

c) From the dropdown box click on “Family”

d) Click on red button on far RHS “Create Family Group”

e) Complete the top section

f) In the bottom section select the family member from Available side

g) Click on > button between the two sides to move member across

h) Repeat steps f) and g) for each member then SUBMIT

Transferring

When prompted or from the Membership screen in you member portal login ...

1. click on the link “Join / Transfer to a new organisation

a) you will then be required to choose an option from the following

- **Full Transfer** - moving your membership to a different surf club. Once your application is approved, you will no longer be a member of your current club. If you select this option and are presently a member of more than one club, you will be asked to select the club you wish to leave.
- **Competition rights transfer** - Keep your membership at your current club(s) but move your competition rights to a new club. You will then have dual membership.
- **Non-competition rights transfer** – Join another club, while keeping your membership and your competition rights at your current club. You will then have dual membership.

2. Follow the rest of the prompts

Steps to help assist in a smooth process in joining the club

Step 1 - Sign up online

1. See previous page for steps
 - a) Should you wish ... omit making payment online and make payment at the club

Step 2 - Pool Proficiency

2. Completion of Pool Proficiency
 - a) Sign on days or first two weeks of nippers
 - Nippers pool swim will be signed off by club Assessor
 - If nipper attends LTS or Squad, nipper pool swim can be signed off by their accredited AustSwim Coach
 - b) If outside a) above ...
 - You need to find an accredited AustSwim Coach to view/assess nipper performing the relevant age proficiency requirements and sign the form accordingly
 - c) It cannot be guaranteed that it can be done at club level as we may not have assessors available or spare water safety in order to complete the pool swim proficiency

Step 3 - Working with Children Bluecard Form

3. Download & complete ... only a financial member can request
 - a) New Application | Link Request | Exemption Application

Step 4 - Team App

4. Download and follow the instructions in the Team App help guide
 - a) Visit your app store
 - Search for "Team App" and download
 - b) Once your club membership has been processed in the system, your request in team app will then be processed
 - you must be a financial member or listed as emergency contact on the adult/parent member to be granted access

Step 5 - Visit the Club

5. Bring the following with you on a Nipper sunday morning
 - a) Signed pool proficiency form
 - b) Birth certificates of nipper/s
 - c) Completed Bluecard form with relevant identification
